Loudoun Hunger Relief Receives \$6114 *Hunger Is* Grant from Safeway Foundation for its Childhood Breakfast Program

Each Safeway location selects a local organization or food bank to receive the donations. Funds for our \$6114 grant were collected by the Safeway stores in Middleburg, Leesburg and Countryside.

LHR truly helps low-income, working families in Loudoun with 68% of those served employed and another 15% actively seeking employment. Residents in need can come
